Robert L. Maxwell and Lathrop/Turner Scholarship
2010–2011 Information Sheet

Purpose:

To provide annual scholarships for full-time, undergraduate students pursuing a degree in: a) a construction-related field within the College of Engineering at The University of Toledo (to include Civil Engineering, Construction Engineering, Mechanical Engineering and Electrical Engineering); **or** b) the Construction Management program at Bowling Green State University; **or** c) enrolled in the McWhorter School of Building Science program at Auburn University (Auburn, AL). Priority consideration will be given to applicants who graduated from high schools in Fulton, Henry, Lucas, Ottawa, and Wood counties (OH) and Lenawee and Monroe counties (MI). Applicants must be U.S. citizens.

Provided that the recipient is making acceptable progress toward his/her degree, renewal scholarship applications may be submitted for consideration.

How to apply:

1. Complete the scholarship application form (three pages).
2. Attach additional required application materials (see page two of the application form):
 - a. Listing of employment, community, extra curricular activities and awards, etc.
 - b. Essays (addressing both questions provided on page two of the application)
 - c. An official copy of your most recent transcript (high school or college)
 - d. School schedule (outline plans for school and co-ops)
 - e. Two signed letters of reference from professors, teachers, guidance counselors, employers, etc.
3. Submit these application materials to: Toledo Community Foundation; Attention: Joanne Olnhausen; 300 Madison Avenue, Suite 1300; Toledo, OH 43604 **by (postmarked) Monday, March 1, 2010.** Please be sure sufficient postage is on the envelope.

Basis for Selection:

1. The criteria used for selection of scholarship recipients include consideration of the following:
 - a. Financial need;
 - b. Scholastic aptitude;
 - c. Prior academic achievement;
 - d. Individual motivation, ability and potential;
 - e. Recommendations from those individuals in 2e. above;
 - f. Personal interview with the Robert L. Maxwell and Lathrop/Turner Scholarship Advisory Committee (if selected as a finalist). **Interviews will be scheduled for mid-April 2010.**
2. The above-stated criteria may be revised from time to time as deemed appropriate by the Robert L. Maxwell and Lathrop/Turner Scholarship Advisory Committee with the approval of the Board of Trustees of the Toledo Community Foundation, Inc.
3. Employees and dependents of employees of the Lathrop Company, its parent company, or any related companies/entities are ineligible to apply for the Robert L. Maxwell and Lathrop/Turner Scholarship.
