**PURPOSE:**

To provide annual scholarships for students pursuing a degree in the electrical/electronics engineering; electrical engineering technology; or computer science related fields. Applicants must be U.S. citizens.

**QUALIFICATIONS FOR ELIGIBILITY:**

1. The applicant must currently be enrolled as a full-time, undergraduate student in one of the following fields: electrical/electronics engineering; electrical engineering technology; or computer science. Engineering or engineering technology programs must be accredited by the Accreditation Board for Engineering Technologies (ABET).
2. The applicant must be attending one of the following post-secondary institutions (located in northwestern Ohio and southeastern Michigan): Bowling Green State University; Monroe County Community College; Ohio Northern University; Owens Community College; Terra Community College; or The University of Toledo.
3. The applicant must complete and submit the Harold W. Wott – IEEE Toledo Section Scholarship application form, including required attachments (see page two of the application form).
4. The applicant must submit an official copy of his/her most recent post-secondary transcript.

**BASIS FOR SELECTION:**

Scholarship recipients will be nominated by the Toledo Community Foundation's Scholarship Advisory Committee and approved by the Foundation's Board of Trustees.

In assessing candidates for this scholarship, the Advisory Committee will take into consideration individual character/motivation, scholastic aptitude and academic achievement, and contributions to the electrical/electronics engineering and/or computer science fields as demonstrated by the information submitted on the scholarship application form, required attachments and academic transcript.

**It is anticipated that at least one (1) \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded for the 2010-2011 academic year. The Toledo Community Foundation will notify (via letter) the scholarship recipient(s) in early May 2010. The recipient(s) will also be recognized at the IEEE Toledo Section Institute Night to be held in November 2010 at The University of Toledo.**
