Horace Gilbert Orser Memorial Scholarship Program Information

The Horace Gilbert Orser Memorial Scholarship was established in 1995 by Mrs. Grace Ford and her family to honor the memory of Mr. Orser and his commitment to both Princeton and the community of Perrysburg. The scholarship is available to graduating high school seniors from Perrysburg High School pursuing a full-time undergraduate degree at one of the following 12 Ivy League Schools: Amherst College, Brown University, Columbia University, Cornell University, Dartmouth College, Harvard University, Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT), Princeton University, Trinity College, University of Pennsylvania, Williams College, or Yale University. This scholarship fully supports the educational expenses including tuition, on-campus room & board, meal plans, books and other education-related fees for the entire duration of the recipient's undergraduate degree (typically 4 years).

APPLICANT ELIGIBILITY

Applications are first carefully reviewed by the Greater Toledo Community Foundation (GTCF) staff to verify their eligibility.

- 1. Must be a U.S. Citizen.
- 2. Must be a graduating high school senior at Perrysburg High School.
- 3. Must be planning to enroll as a full-time student.
- 4. Must be accepted to one of the 12 eligible Ivy League Schools.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Consideration for this award is strictly contingent upon a student's acceptance to one of the eligible schools.

- If two or more applicants are eligible, the recipient will be chosen based on the criteria below.
 - 1. Academic Achievements
 - 2. Scholastic Aptitude (Test Scores)

Late July	Payments: Scholarships are paid directly to post-secondary institution (never directly to student).
